Jobs of Hope is thrilled to announce our newest program service, "House of Hope!" This new endeavor will add a 14 bed low barrier sober living home to our program.

Unfortunately, when you're worrying about where you're going to sleep, accessing services and looking for work will always become secondary to finding shelter and a meal. Success in any program can best be managed by breaking the cycle of homelessness and moving individuals into stable housing. The "House of Hope" low barrier innovative approach to a sober living home will be unique to Weld County and has the potential to profoundly improve the success rates among previously incarcerated homeless individuals and improve their quality of life by transforming those who wish to leave behind their past legal issues to become better fathers and men, thereby transforming generations.

## Director's Corner

When faced with adversity, how an agency responds defines who they are. When faced with a global pandemic, Jobs of Hope rose to the challenge to ensure we took care of our three most significant assets—Participants, staff and the community.

As an essential service provider in Weld County, we never stopped serving our participants. In fact, we expanded our services. Our staff was equipped with the technology and resources needed to provide support remotely and when needed, in person at a safe capacity. In a time where the need for services was most needed, Jobs of Hope participants were assured that they had access to the resources they needed to be successful.

Like most agencies, the past two years have come with many unexpected challenges for Jobs of Hope. One of the most challenging barriers for individuals being released from incarceration was homelessness. Of those who enrolled in our program in 2020, 67% were identified as homeless and sleeping in conditions not meant for habitation. As of today, that number is now at 76%.

Once again, Jobs of Hope is met with the reality that we must continue to do more. As a small nonprofit, we have taken a leap of faith and are proud to announce our newest program service, "House of Hope." There isn't a day that goes by where the staff and I don't share this vision of hope with an understanding that when people have hope, they genuinely take pride and do more for themselves and others.

I am humbled and inspired by the passion, determination and support of our staff, leadership and community to make a difference. Jobs of Hope and our community can stand proud and be honored by its commitment to serve. I ask that you pray for Jobs of Hope as we enter this new endeavor.

# You're Invited To The JOH Annual Banquet


