## Eligibility

- Men 18 and older
- Released from incarceration within the last 3 years
  - Previous or current gang affiliation and/or
  - Criminal conviction that inhibits your ability to obtain employment

## Expectations

- Participants are asked to leave behind homelessness and gang life.
- Refrain from using drugs, alcohol and substances that impede their ability to obtain or retain employment.
- Act in a professional and respectful manner in how they talk and interact with others.

## Who We Are

Jobs of Hope is a life-changing, faith-based community organization with a goal of seeing transformation happen in the lives of men who wish to leave behind years of legal problems, gang affiliation and substance abuse.

We strive to support men leaving incarceration with services and tools that will enable them to re-enter society and be successful contributors to the larger community both in terms of economic opportunities (jobs) and relationships.

## Our Services

### CASE MANAGEMENT



Our Re-entry Case Manager/Navigator meets with participants one-on-one to assist them in a fully integrated, holistic and collaborative plan that uses a team approach with community partners to meet self identified short and long term goals in a supportive, non-judgmental environment.

### "MEN OF VALOR" CERTIFIED LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

Derived from Global Priority Solutions, the "Men of Valor" program explores character values in a self-discovery process to create a personal transformation.

The goal is for men to see themselves as "Men of Valor" and share this newfound hope with their children to be better fathers, their spouses to be better partners and their colleagues to be better employees and friends. Most of all, the goal is to become a beacon of hope for future participants.

### REVITALIZING LIFE GROUP

Revitalizing Life Group is an addictions program that creates an environment where individuals can explore what it means to live in a place of recovery and hope. Participants of the group develop a brotherhood bringing support to each other.

### HOUSE OF HOPE



Our 14-bed transitional supportive housing service provides temporary housing to those enrolled in the Jobs of Hope Program who self-identify as homeless or sleeping in conditions not meant for habitation.
